She stated that a third year student is working on the cover with 3 different sizes for the booklet. Susan is waiting for 3 estimates for 3 different print sizes for the booklet. Dave Lenker, also liaison for the Business Advisory Committee, suggested perhaps town businesses could help fund the booklet by booklet advertisement if suitable. It also was suggested that advertising the booklet, once completed, might be done via Township web site and newsletter and at the Township Fall Festival.

The markers are to be located in the same location as before, and not on the bypass. New Kingstown and Hogestown signs will be replicated and installed in the two villages.
