David Lenker will be approached about digging the holes for the trees.

Parks and rec has offered to help. We will contact the churches about helping – possibly serving the hot food. Ask townspeople to each make/bring a dessert. Date coordination with band, R.J. County Commissioners have passed the proposed 2011 budget. NKV has been approved for \$75,000.00 for ADA improvements - or textured sidewalks at an intersection. We will know for sure in the spring if the money will actually come through. The bid process must be gone through first.
