ORDINANCE NO. 5 of 2008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SILVER SPRING,  
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 79-5, WHICH CREATED THE  
TOWNSHIP BUSINESS ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, the Township of Silver Spring (the "Township") by Ordinance No. 79- created the Township Business Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to increase the number of members of the Township Business Advisory Board and make individuals who own businesses located in the Township eligible to be appointed to the Township Business Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Silver Spring, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Ordinance No. 79-5, Section 2 is hereby amended to read follows:

SECTION 2. The Business Advisory Board shall be composed of seven (7) members, which shall be residents of the Township or individuals who own businesses located in the Township.

SECTION TWO: All provisions of Ordinance No. 79-5 not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY. If any provision, sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: REPEALER. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective in five (5) days of the date of enactment.
