ORDINANCE NO. 9 of 2008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SILVER SPRING,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING,
MODIFYING AND CHANGING THE SILVER SPRING TOWNSHIP
SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE OF 2007

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Silver Spring,
Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Silver Spring Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of 2007 (the "SALDO") is hereby amended as follows and shall be known as the Silver Spring Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of 2008:

A. Section 203 of the SALDO is hereby amended to add a definition for "Ground Source Heat Pump System" to read as follows:

"A well or wells installed for the purpose of heating or cooling. The system can be either closed or open loop."

B. Section 402.05.11.c.iii of the SALDO is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Proposed measures to control potential adverse environmental impacts on groundwater quality and storm water management resulting from the development and utilization of the property to include the installation of a ground source heat pump system."

SECTION 2: In all other respects, the SALDO shall remain as heretofore enacted, ordained and amended.

SECTION 3: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.
