ORDINANCE NO. 17 of 2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SILVER SPRING,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
REPEALING THE AMUSEMENT TAX

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Silver Spring,
Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinances 77-6, 81-1 and 95-1, which established the Amusement Tax in
the Township of Silver Spring, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2010.
