ORDINANCE NO. 4 of 2010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SILVER SPRING,  
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3 of 2000, WHICH REGULATES  
PARKING OF VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS  
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SILVER SPRING

WHEREAS, the Township of Silver Spring (the “Township”) by Ordinance No. 3 of 2000 created parking regulations for vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend Ordinance No. 3 of 2000 with regard to the Resident Permit Parking Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Silver Spring, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 5.A. of Ordinance No. 3 of 2000 is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The public streets in a residential area designated for resident permit parking are hereby established in Schedule II of this ordinance. Streets may be added or removed from Schedule II by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 2: All provisions of Ordinance No. 3 of 2000 not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance

would have been adopted and enacted as it such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision had not been included therein.

SECTION 4: REPEALER. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
