

DECLARING CERTAIN ACTS AGAINST GOOD ORDER AND GOVERNMENT, HEALTH AND CLEANLINESS OF SILVER SPRING TOWNSHIP TO BE UNLAWFUL AND PROHIBITING THE SAME.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Silver Spring Township, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that from and after passage of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person within the limits of this Township, on the streets, public places, or elsewhere there in;

SECTION 1 To commit a breach of the peace, to be guilty of vagrancy, riotous or disorderly practice, to engage in fighting, assaulting, or in inciting others to fight, assault, or engaged in any unlawful act tending to imperil the personal security or endanger the property of citizens, or the property of companies, corporations, or of the Township or others.

SECTION 2 To use publicly, profane or blasphemous language, commit open lewdness or any act of public indecency, make any indecent exposure of the person; to be found publicly in a state of intoxication or drunkenness; to be gathered together in disorderly assemblies on the streets or in drinking places; gambling houses, or houses of prostitution.

SECTION 3 To make wilfully or cause to be made loud, boisterous or unseemly noise or disturbance to the annoyance of the peaceable residents nearby, more particularly between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A. M.

SECTION 4 To carry wilfully concealed upon his or her person any firearms, razor, dirk or bowie-knife, blackjack or handbilly, or any other deadly weapon.

SECTION 5 To throw wantonly any stone, brick, or other missile, or to explode any torpedo, bomb, firecrackers or fireworks of any kind in the streets, alleys, or highways or to raise any false alarm of fire or other calamity.

SECTION 6 Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof before any Justice-of-the -Peace be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$100.00 for each offense, and cost of prosecution, and in default thereof suffer imprisonment for a period not exceeding 30 days.

SECTION 7 All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
